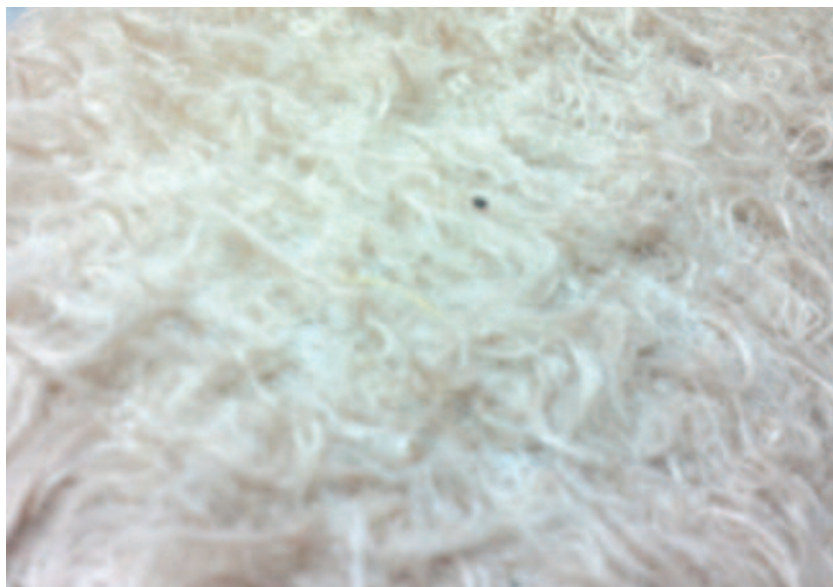


Fig. 2 – A coste o côtelé.

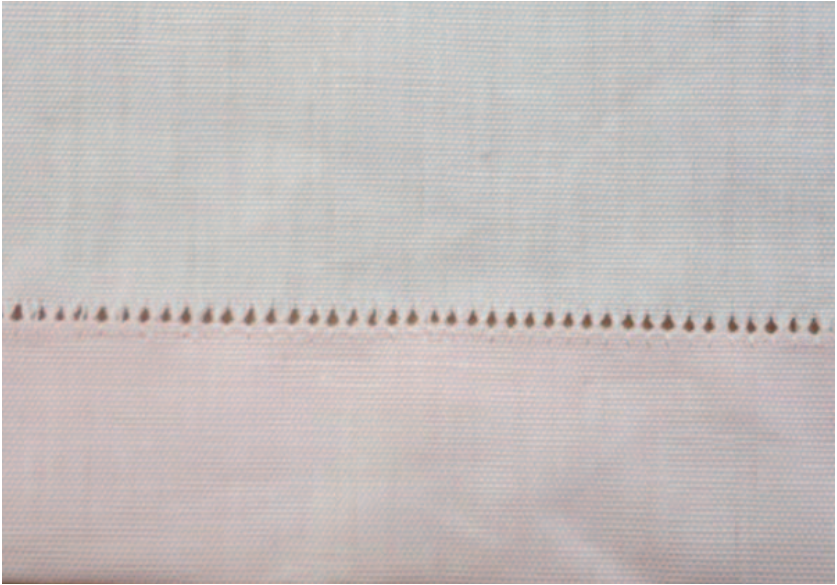


Fig. 4 – A giorno o à jour.

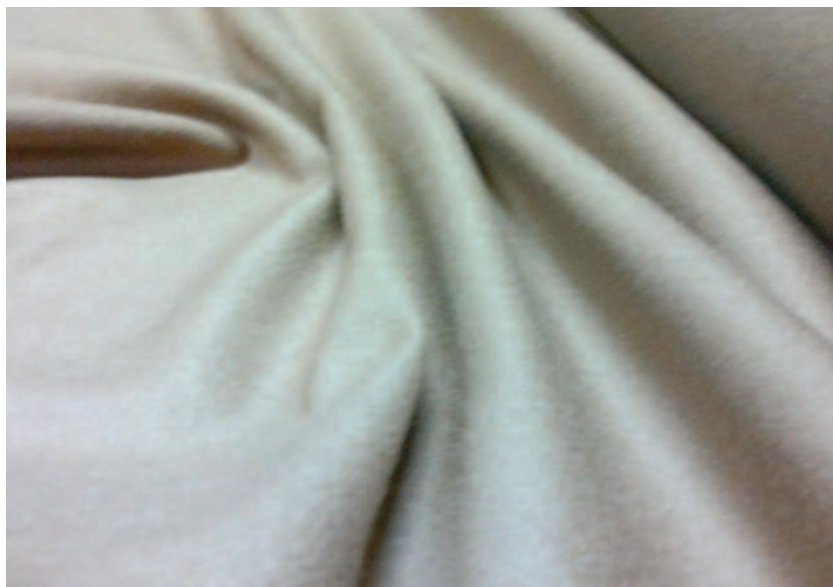


Fig. 6 – Alpaca.

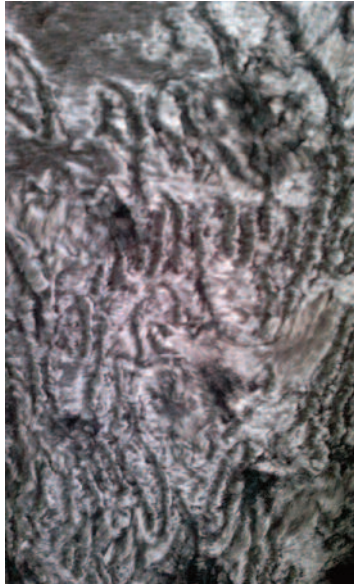


Fig. 8 – Astrakan.

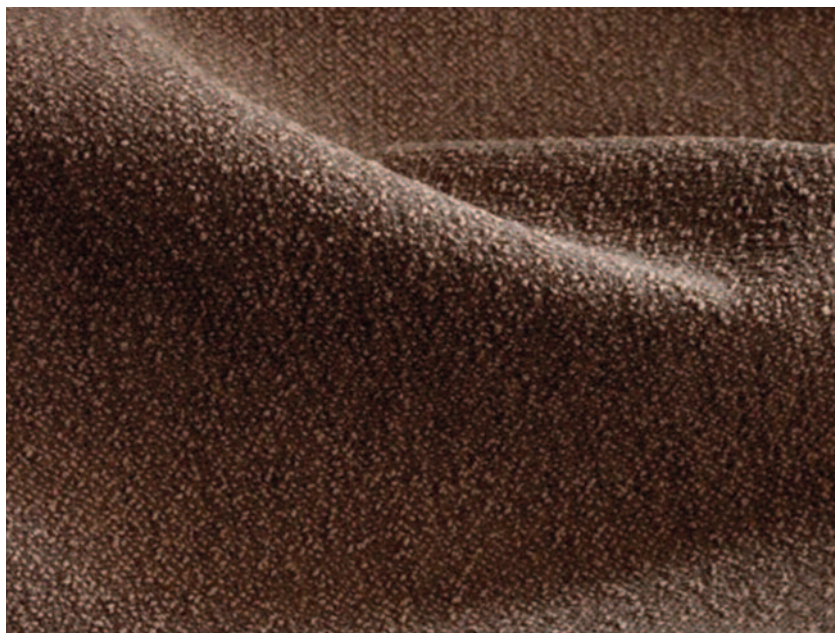


Fig. 10 – Batista.

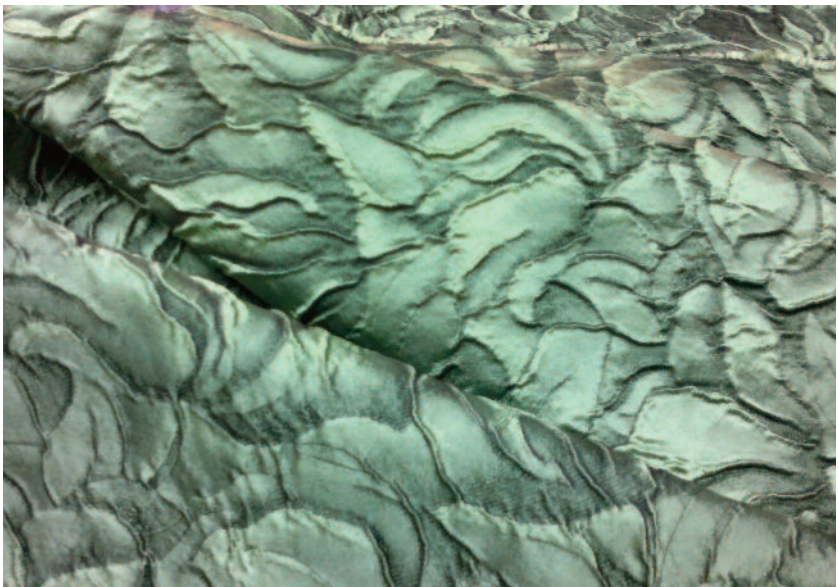


Fig. 12 – Bouclé.

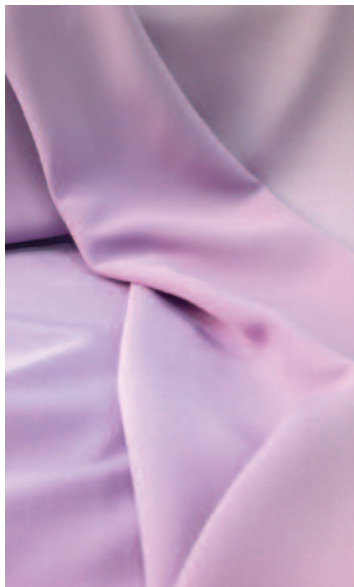


Fig. 16 – Cady.

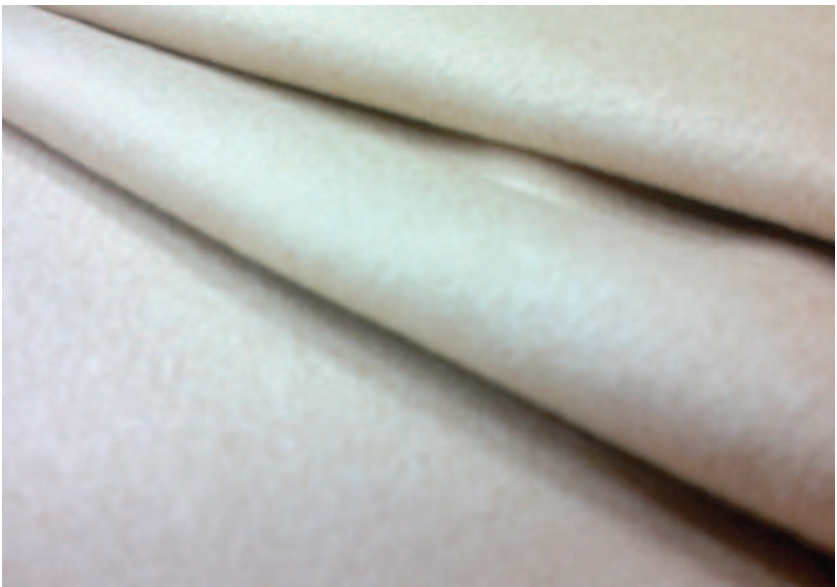


Fig. 20 – Cannelé o cannellato.

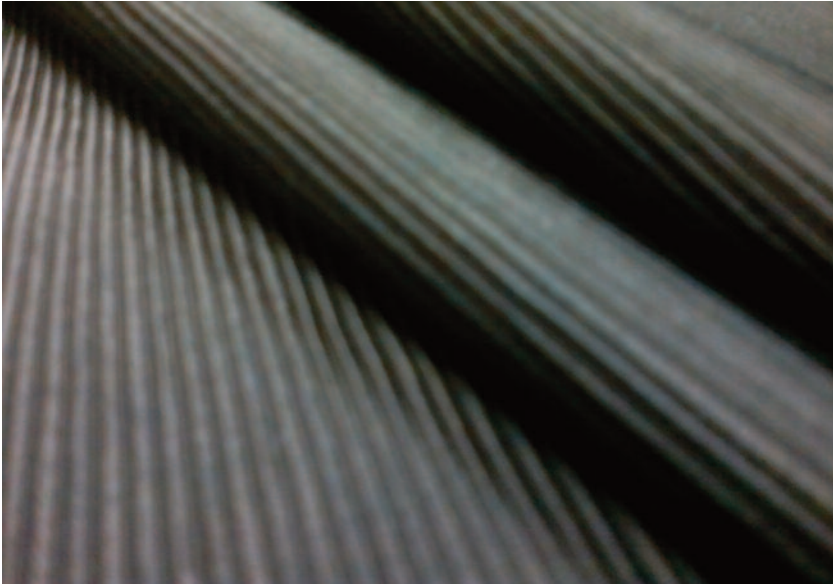


Fig. 21 – Canvas.

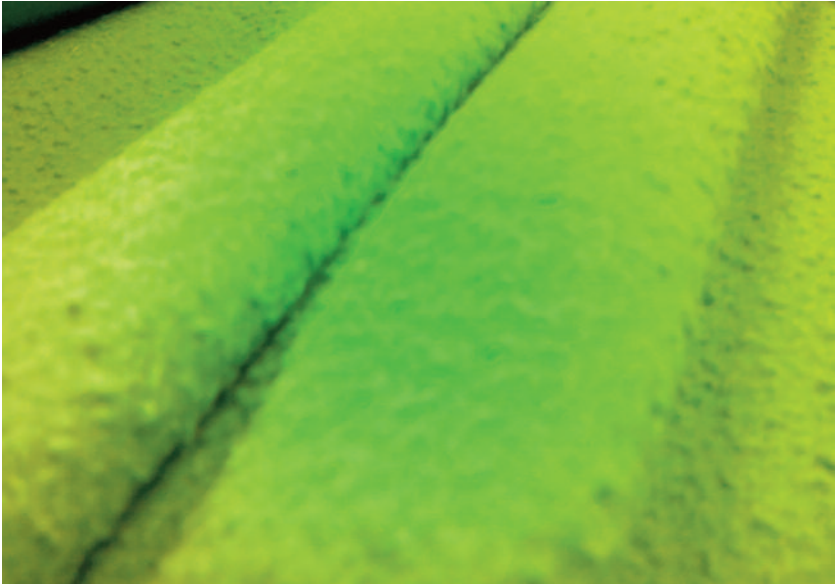


Fig. 23 – Casentino.

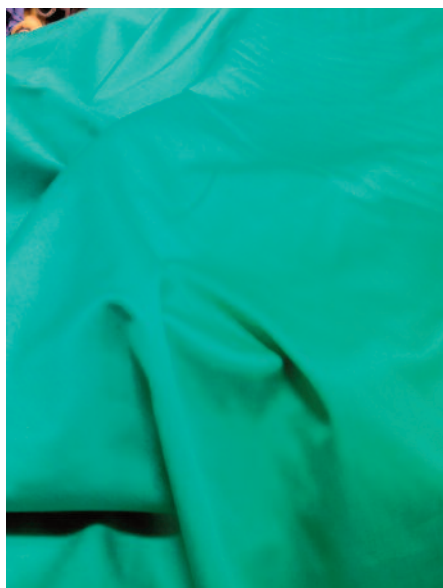


Fig. 26 – Charmeuse.

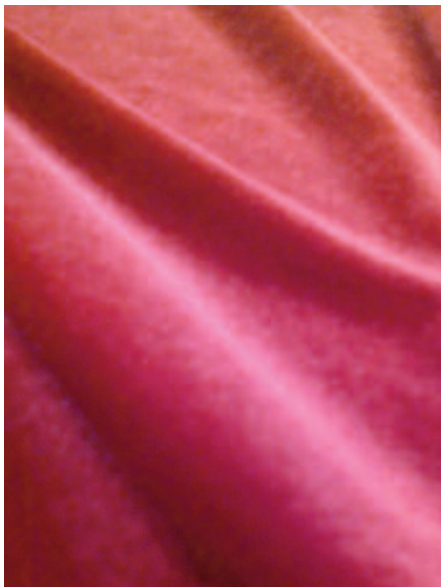


Fig. 30 – Ciniglia.

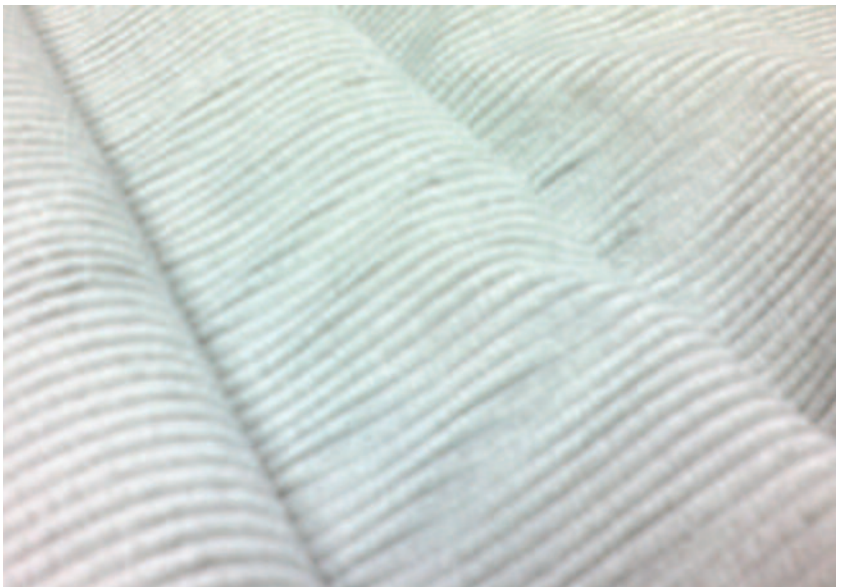


Fig. 32 – Cord.

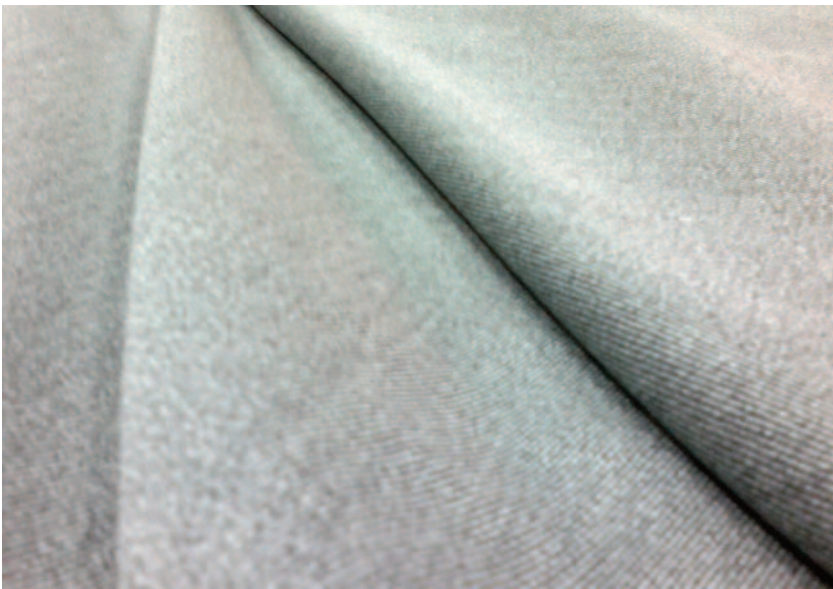


Fig. 34 – Cover o covercoat.

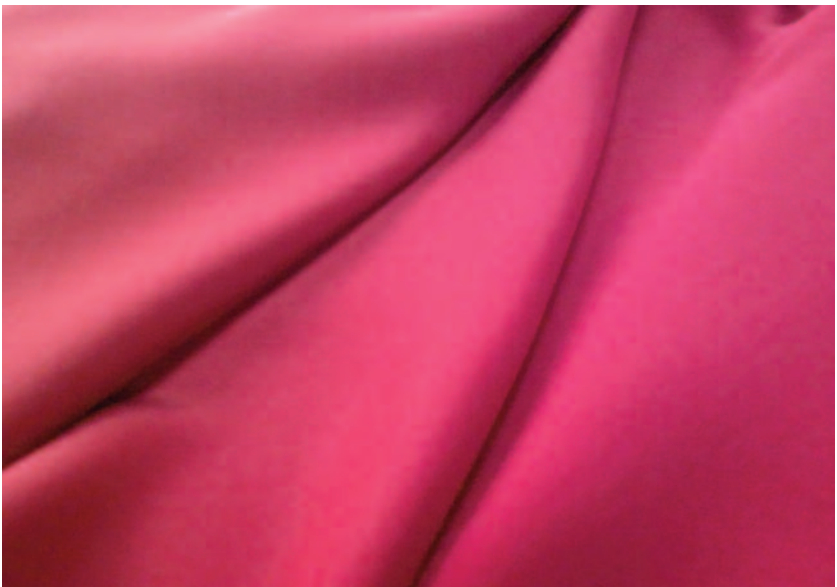


Fig. 36 – Crêpe de Chine.

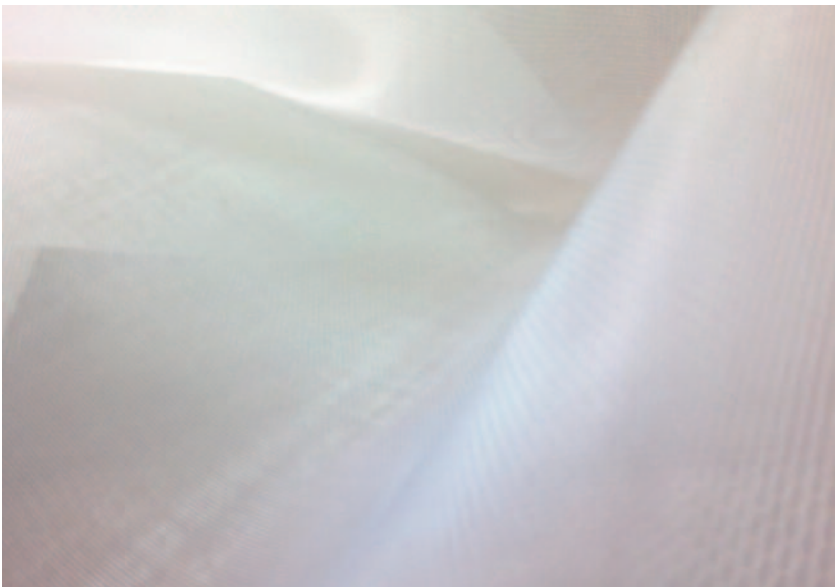


Fig. 40 – Crinolina.

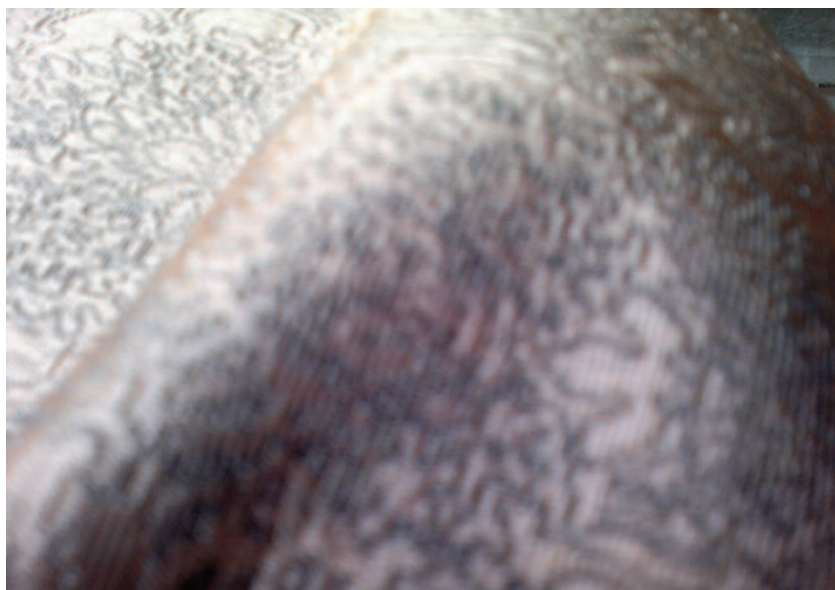


Fig. 42 – Damascato.

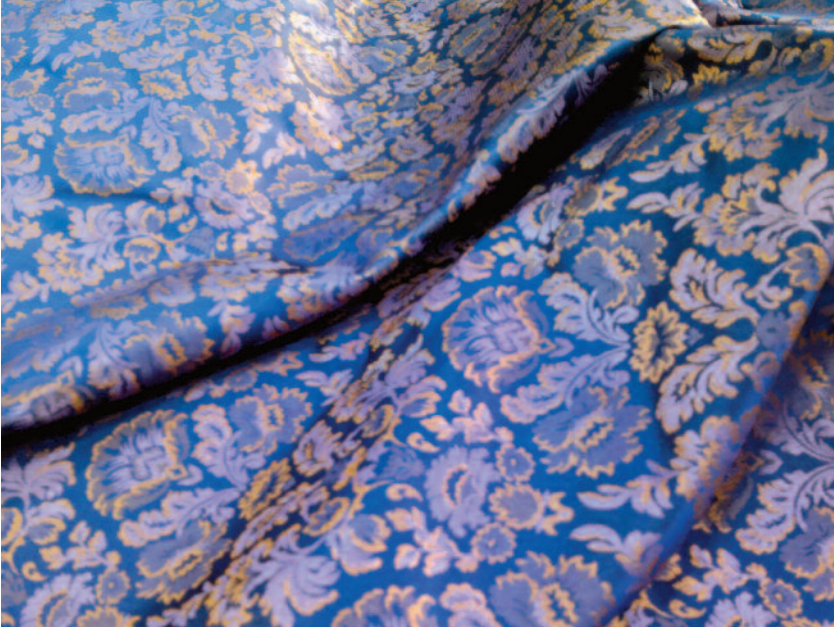


Fig. 43 – Damasco.

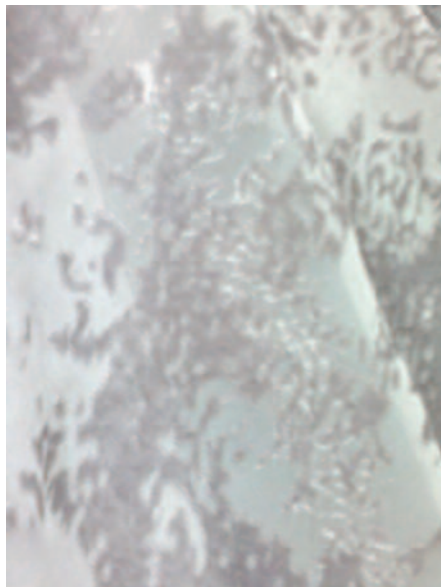


Fig. 47 – Dévoré.

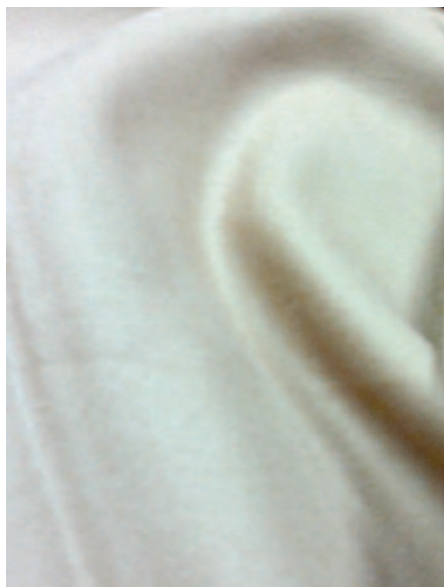


Fig. 48 – Doeskin o pelle di daino.

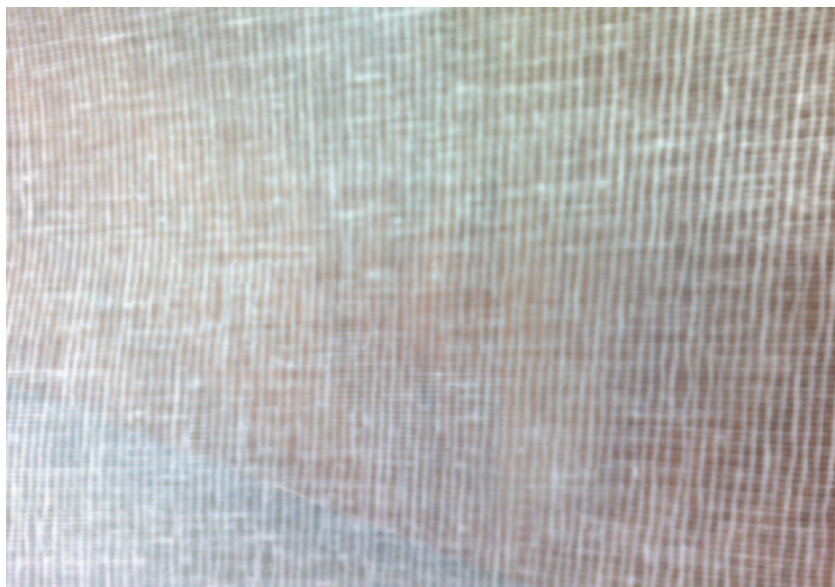


Fig. 55 – Étamine.

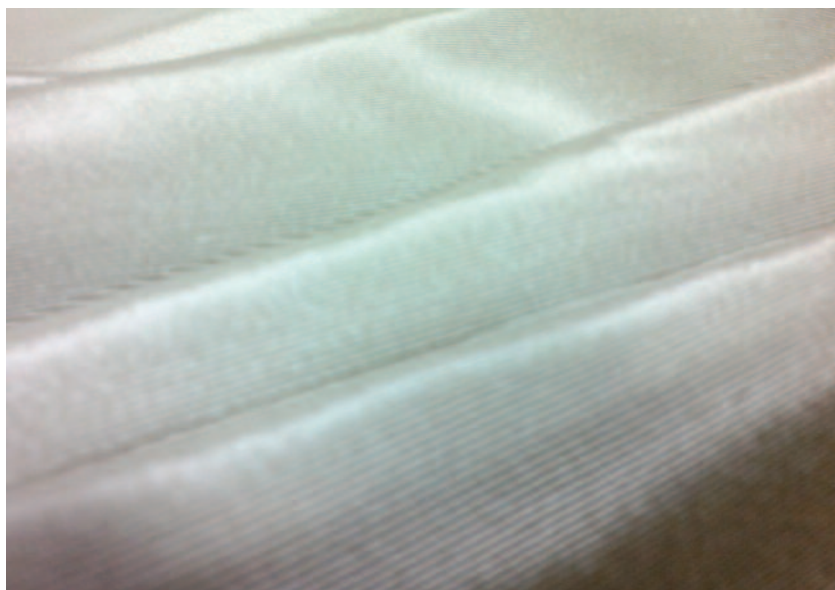


Fig. 56 – Faille.

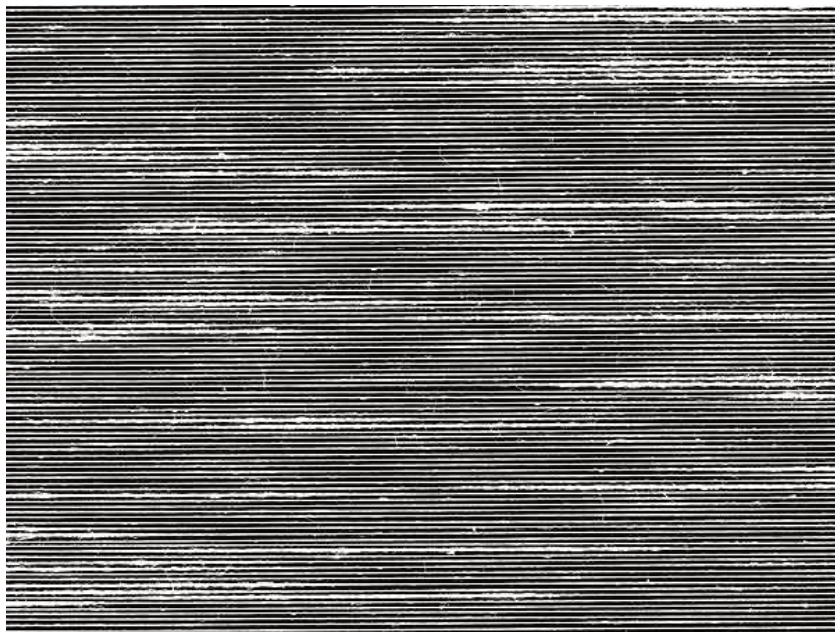


Fig. 59 – Fiammato o flammé.

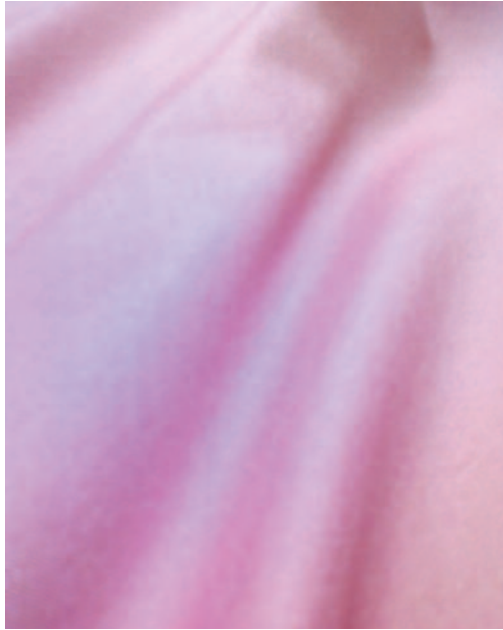


Fig. 64 – Flanella.

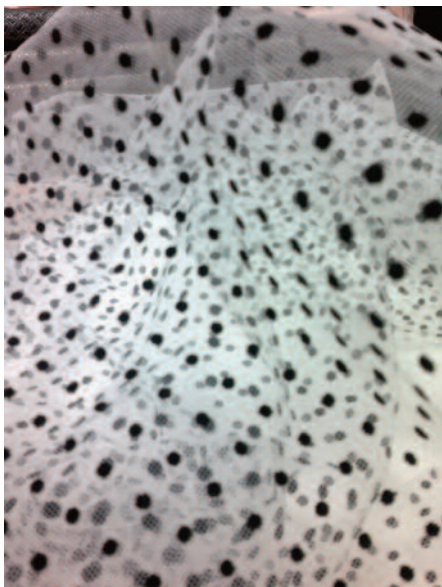


Fig. 65 – Floccato o flock.

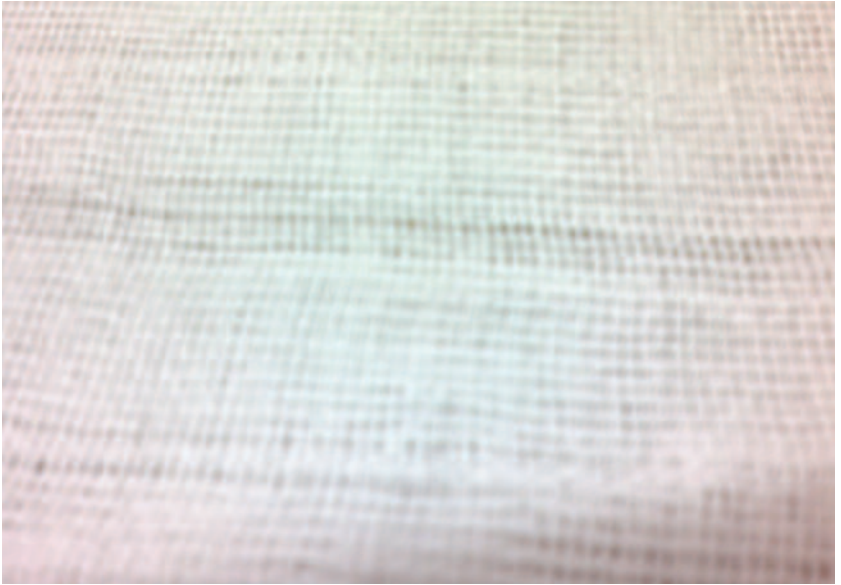


Fig. 71 – Garza.

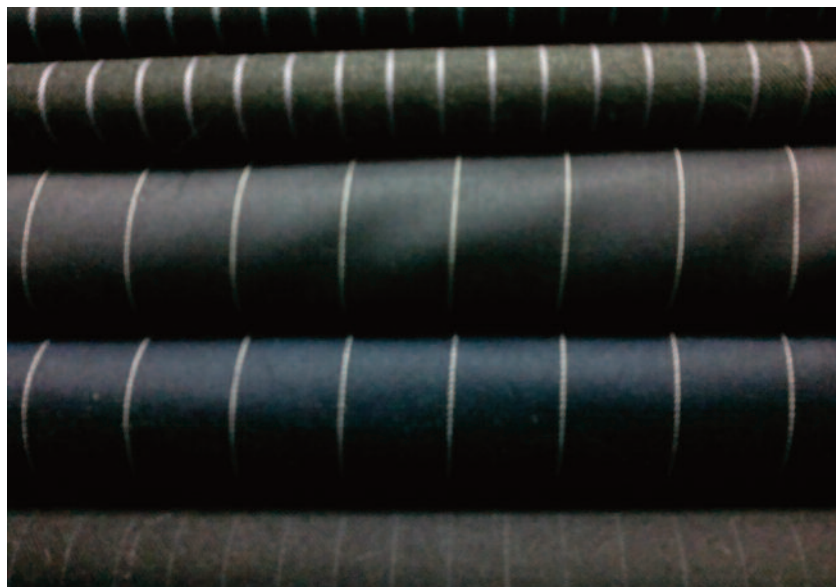


Fig. 73 – Gessato.

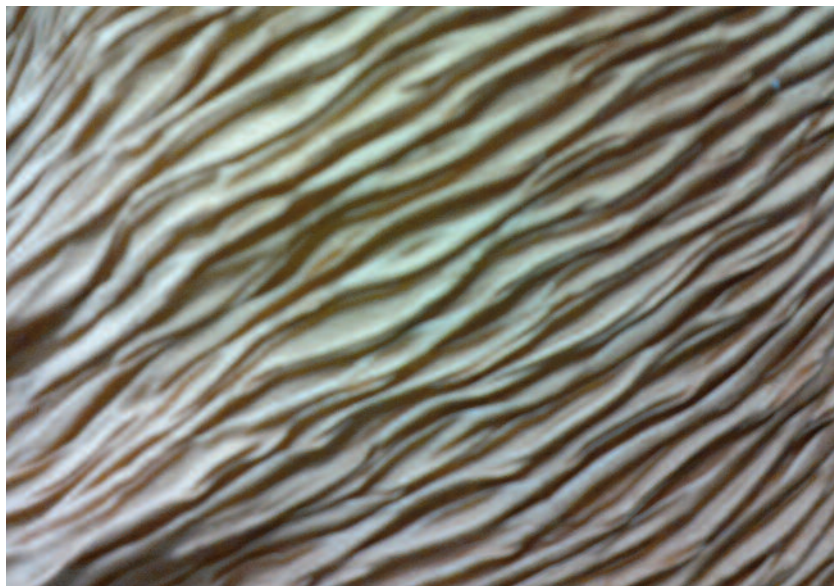


Fig. 75 – Goffrato.

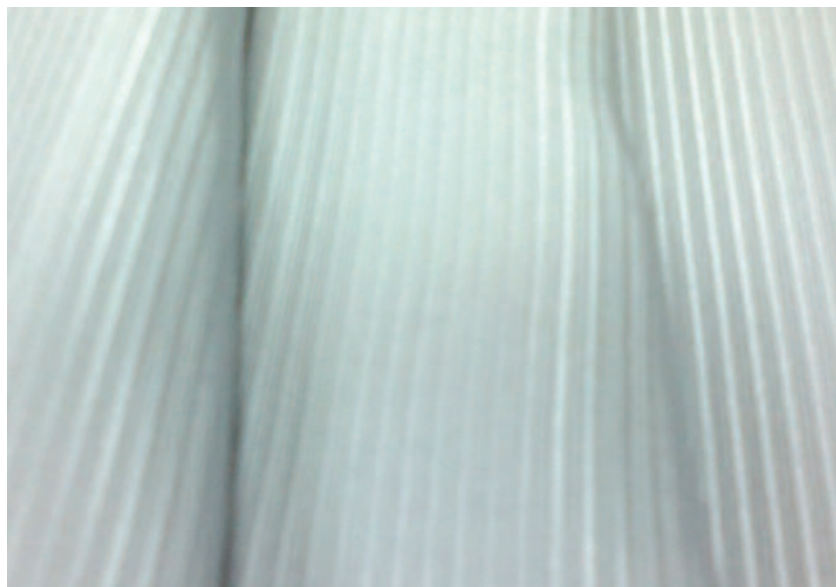


Fig. 77 – Gros-grain.

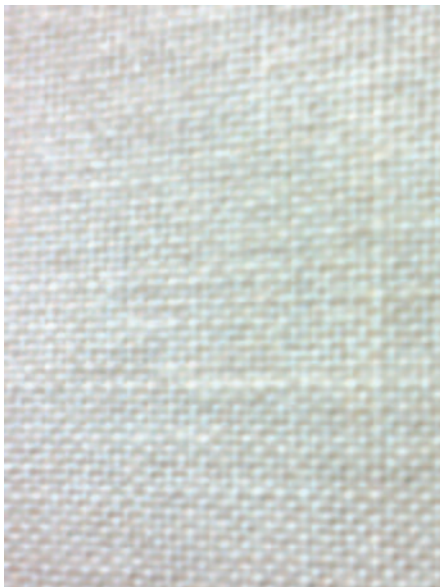


Fig. 80 – Iuta.

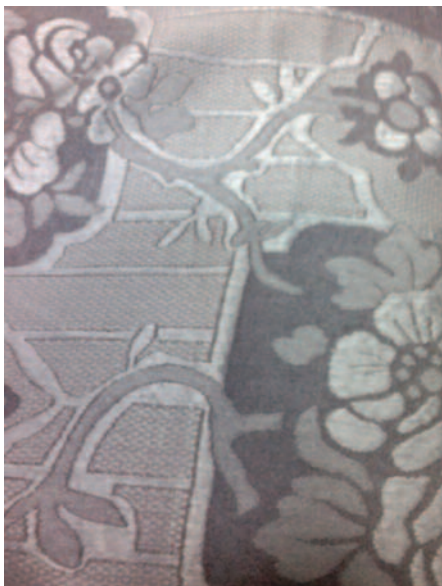


Fig. 81 – Jacquard.

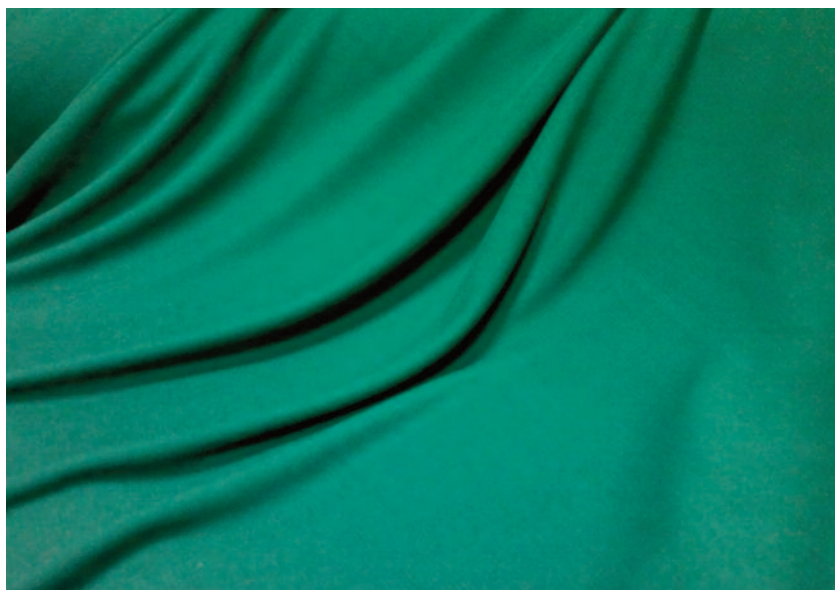


Fig. 82 – Jersey.

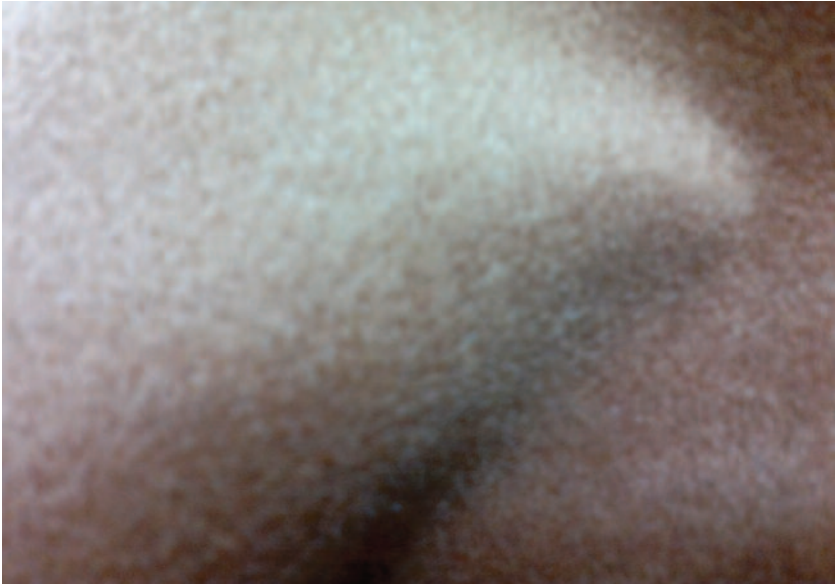


Fig. 83 – Kamel hair o pelo di cammello.

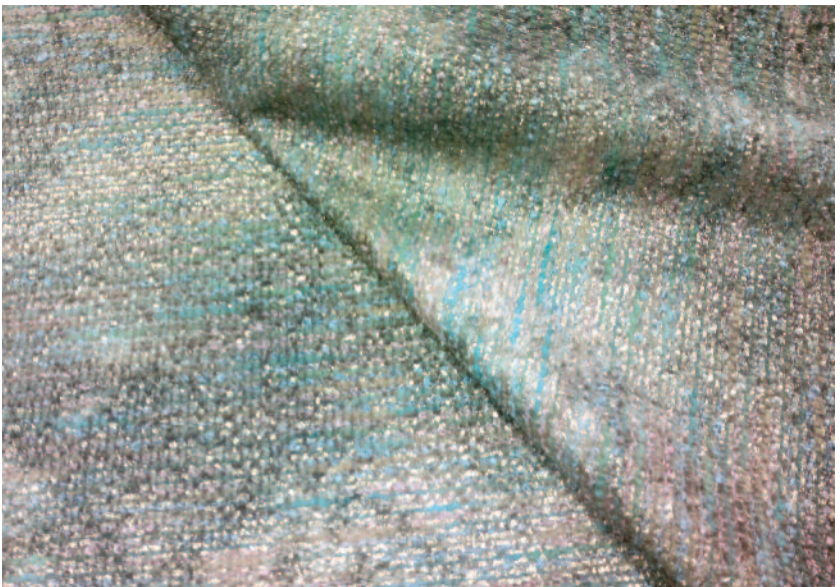


Fig. 84 – Lamé o laminato.

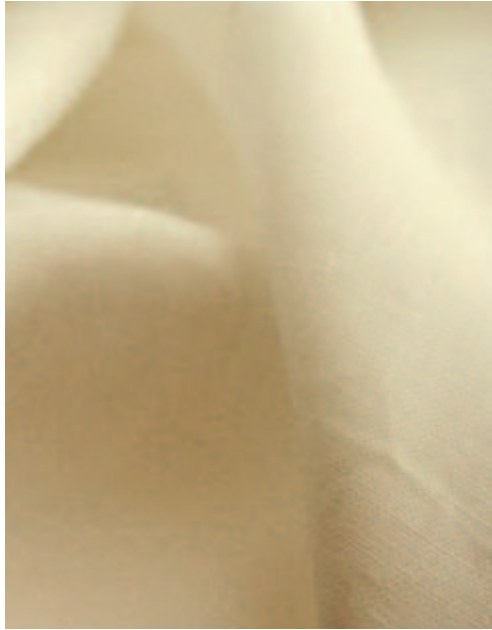


Fig. 87 – Lino.

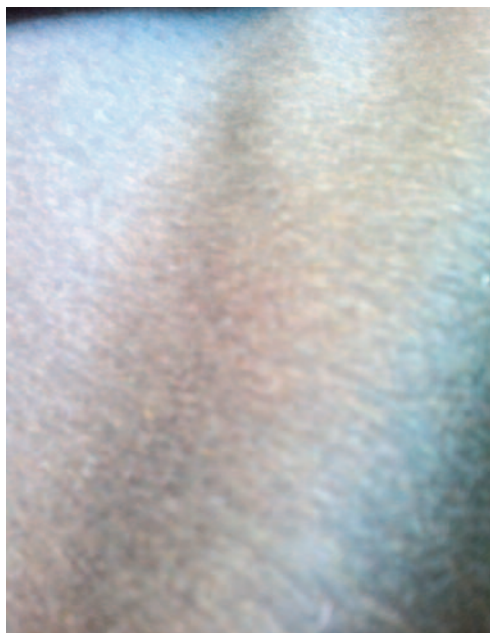


Fig. 88 – Loden.

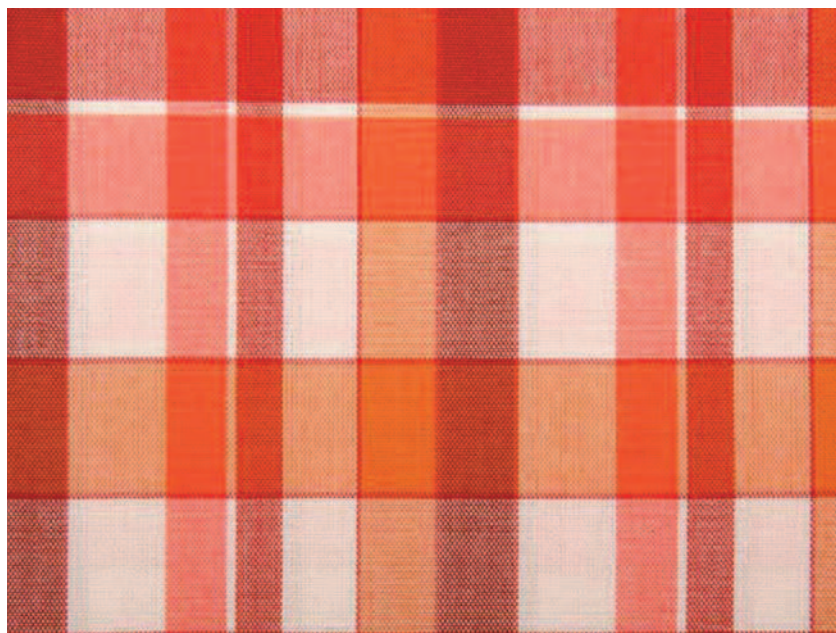


Fig. 90 – Madras.

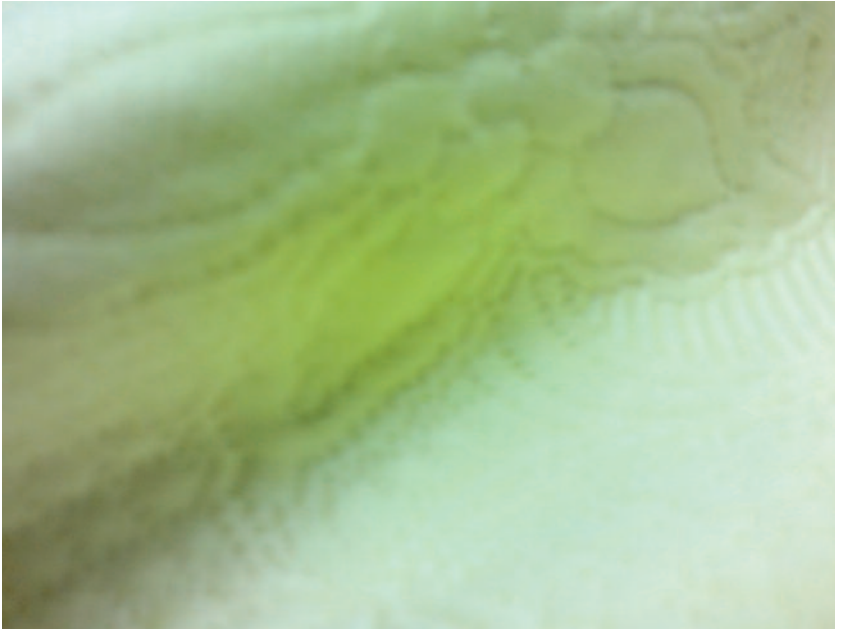


Fig. 91 – Matelassé.

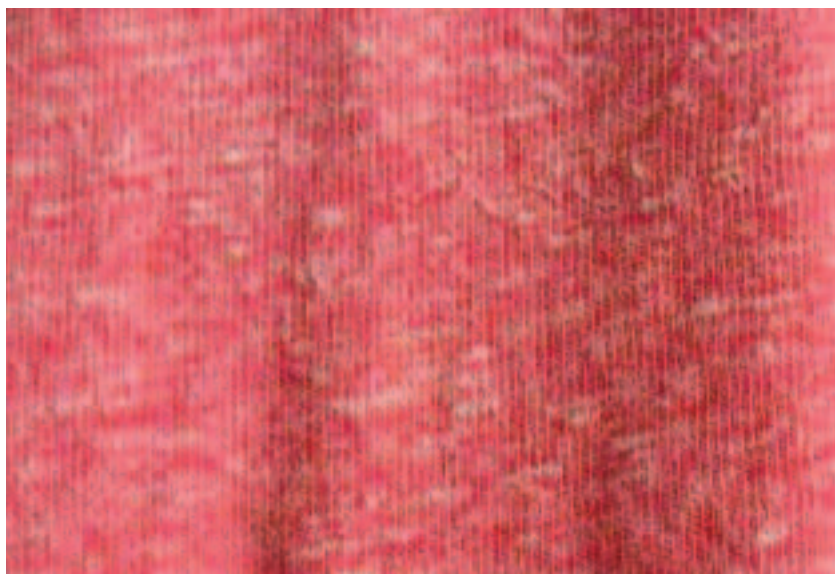
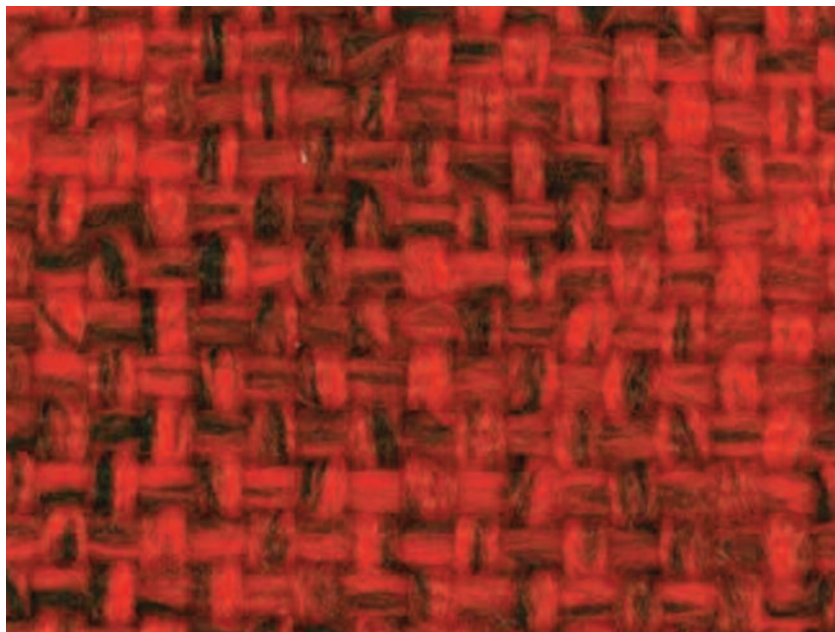


Fig. 92 – Mélangés.

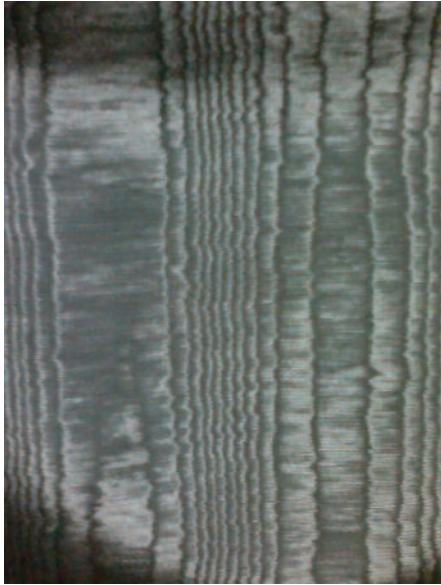


Fig. 94 – Moiré o marezzato.

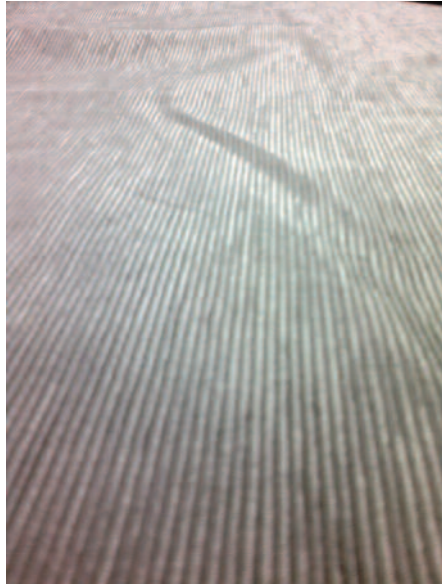


Fig. 99 – Ottoman.

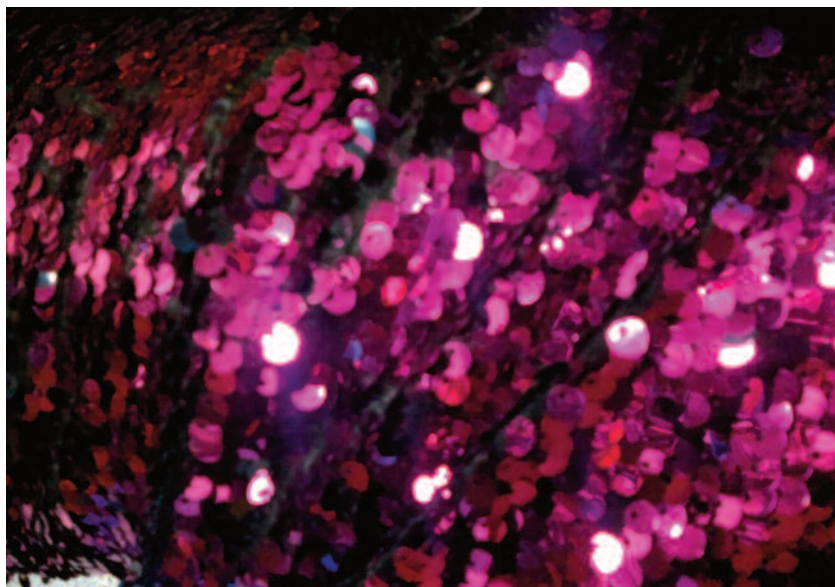


Fig. 101 – Paillettes.

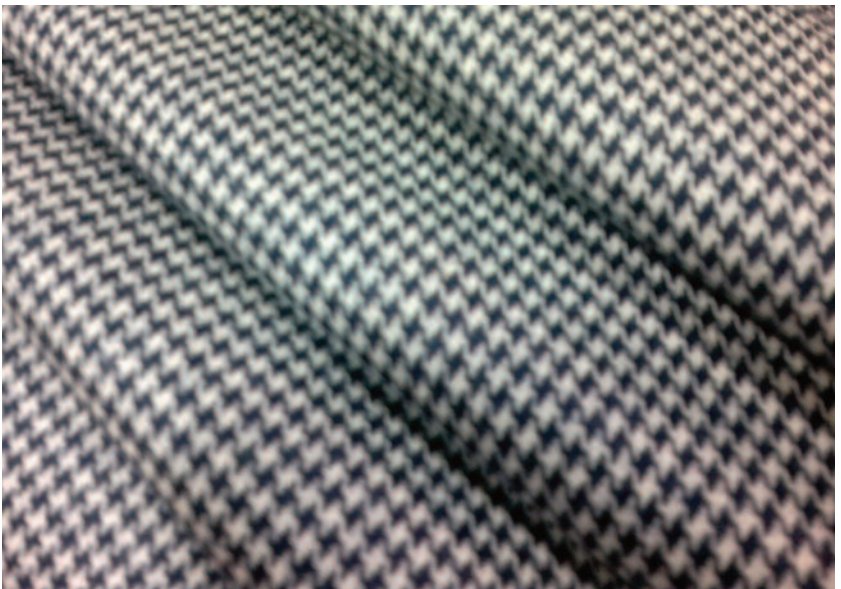


Fig. 104 – Pied de poule.

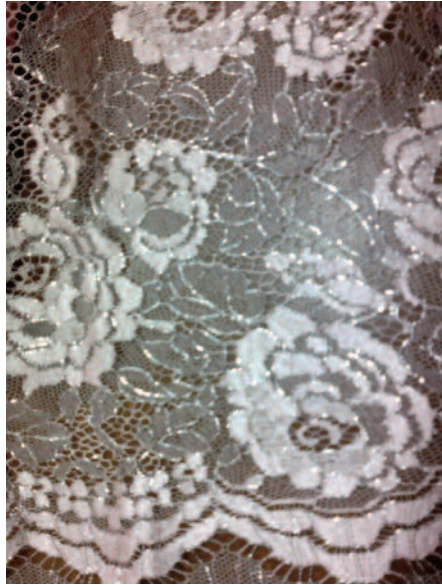


Fig. 107 – Pizzo.

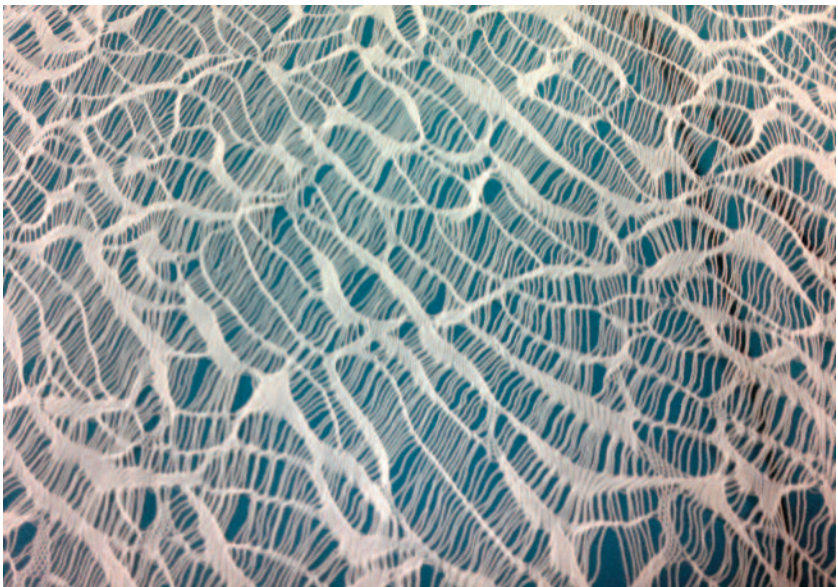


Fig. 108 – Rete.

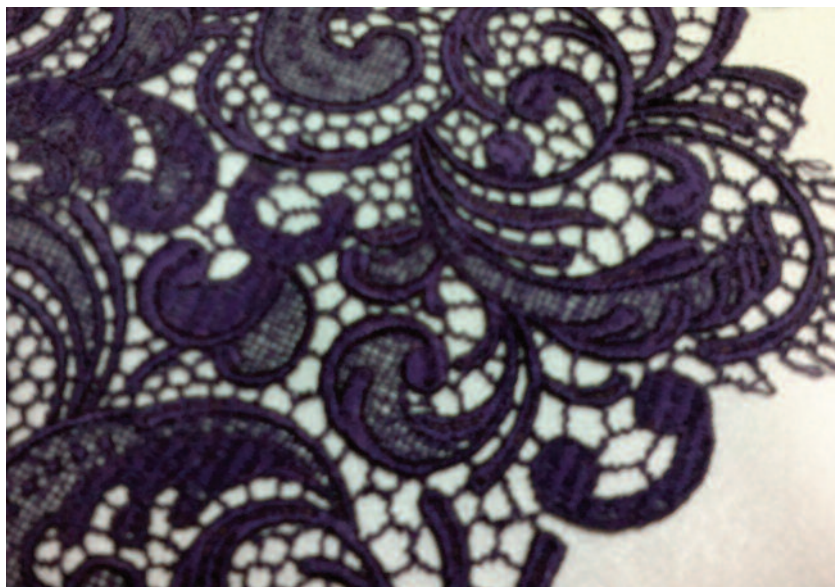


Fig. 109 – Macramè.

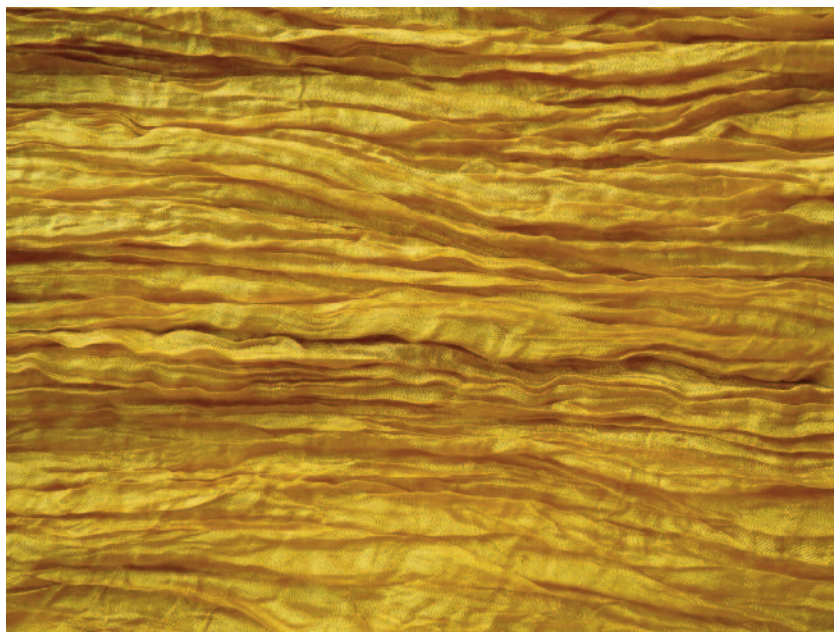


Fig. 111 – Plissé.

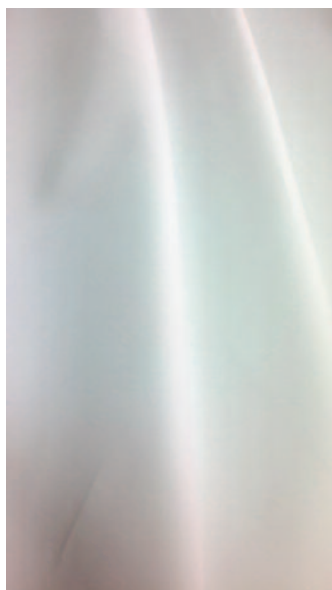


Fig. 113 – Popeline.

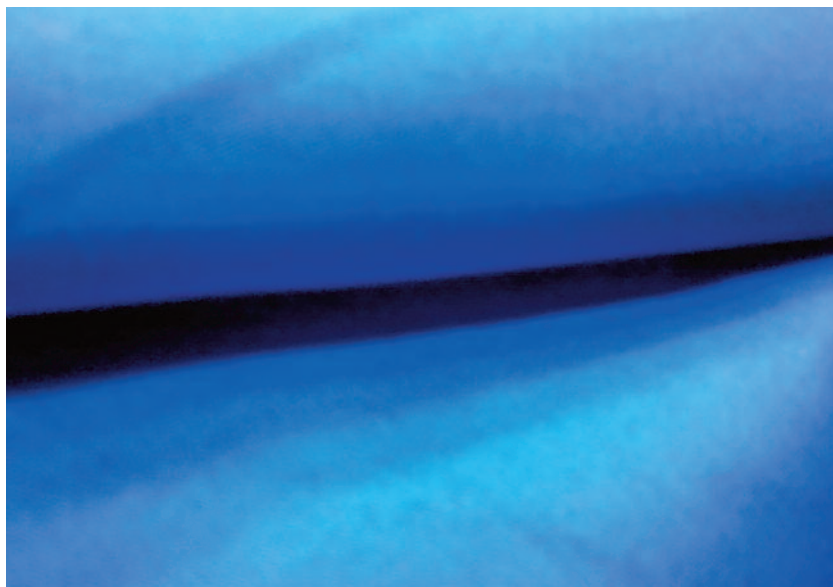


Fig. 115 – Raso.

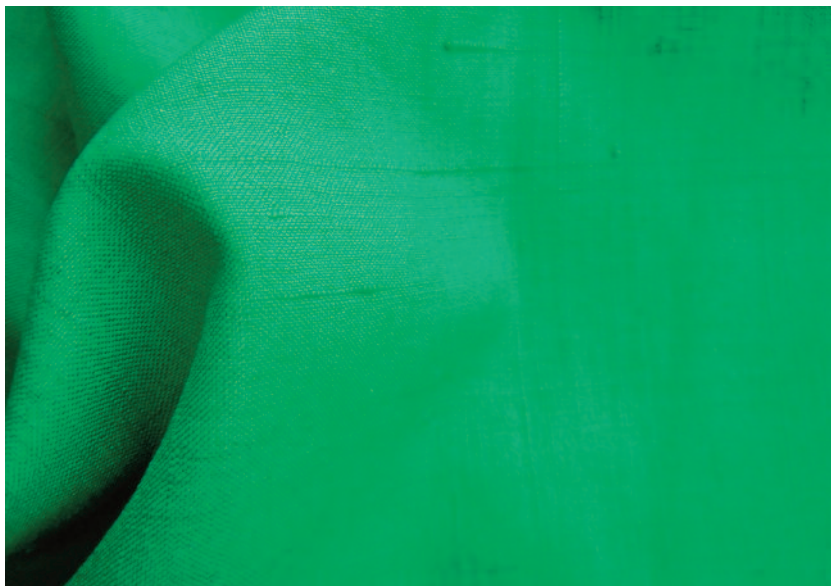


Fig. 117 – Shantung.

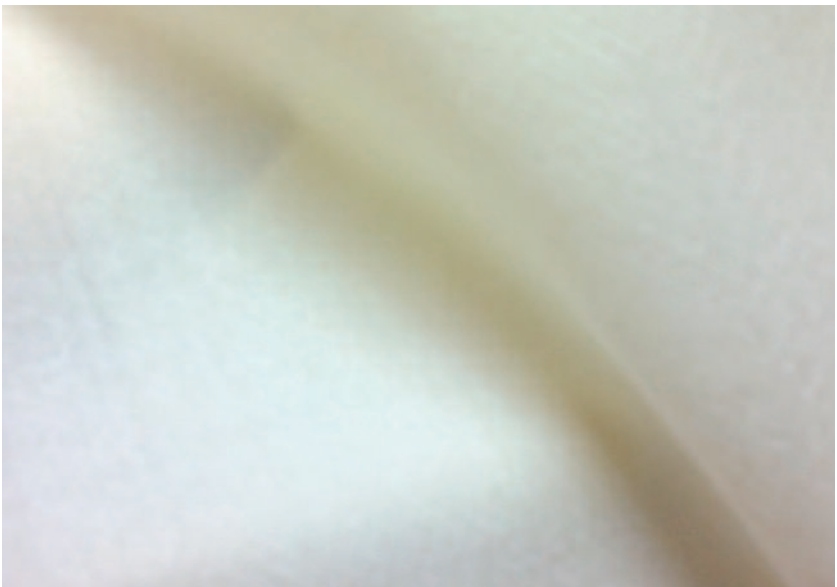


Fig. 125 – Vaiella.

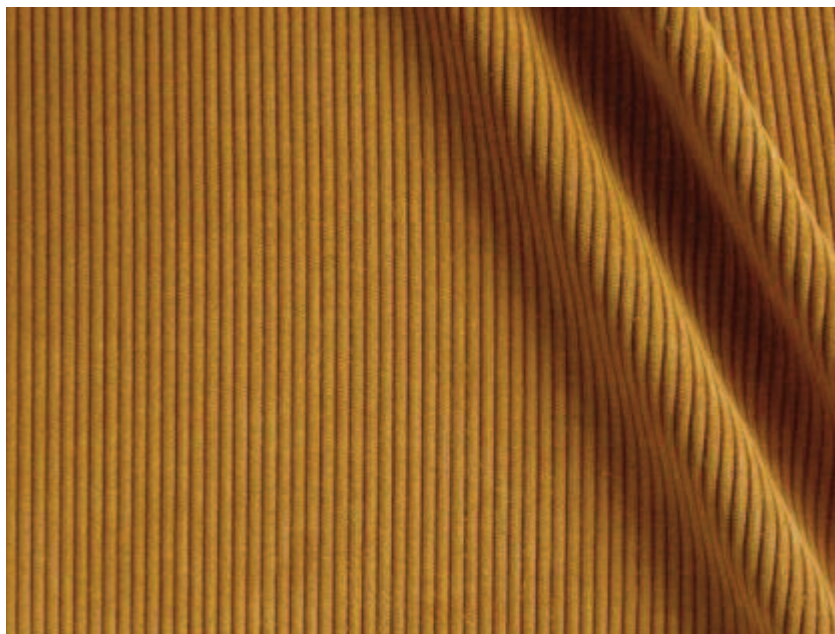


Fig. 126 – Velluti.

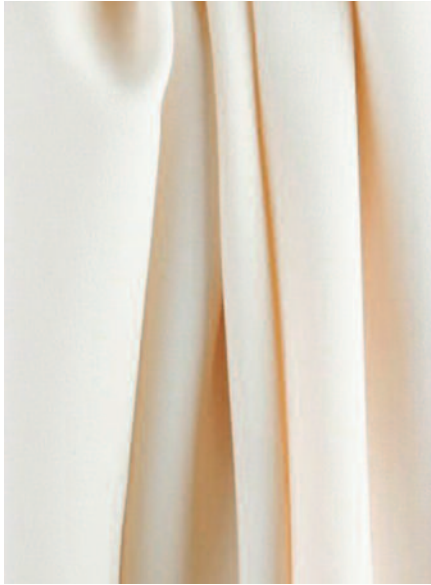


Fig. 127 – Vigogna.
