Video Production

Our final video is based on our first story about coffee history, called "Kaldi's Enchanted Journey: A Tale of Coffee's Wondrous Past". The script for this video was created via ChatGPT, by asking it to write a one minute video script based on the story mentioned above. Afterwards, the script has similarly been used for narration of the video. The narration itself, composed of transferring the script-text to NaturalReaders.com website, where we could choose our narrator as well as their tone of the voice. We opted for a child narrator as we wanted to make our spectator feel involved, like they are listening to one of their friends. Once we had our narration, we moved our process to <u>Canva.com</u>, which we chose as the main cutting and production platform. As Canva offers clear video design, it was easy for us to work with it. The next step was to generate images for our video to come to life. For this part of the project, we worked on Adobe Firefly (Beta) website, where we could choose from many styles, sizes and content types. Adobe Firefly wasn't restricted by a particular number of available prompts per day, which made our work more time-efficient. Once we had all of the pictures needed to represent the story and to match with the narrator, we adjusted the length of each scene, for a final story look to come together. However, we didn't stop here, as we believed our video story lacked something, specific atmosphere. To evoke a sense of imagination in the viewer, we decided to include a subtle background music to the narration. We opted for a melody with a soft rhythm called "inspiration", retrieved from <u>Pixabay.com</u>. All in all, once we fused these various elements, a video story was formed.

Story writing & Book production

The basis of our portfolio are our stories, without them we wouldn't be able to create the books or the video. To be able to form quality stories, we have adopted following approach. With each story, we firstly asked ChatGPT about the topic, to understand what information we are working with, and what we can expect our stories to include. Such background information allowed us to extend our subsequent prompts. Then, we moved on specifics, with the goal to start developing atmosphere around the story. The most used prompts include:

- Developing a story-world
- Outlining a mood-board
- Developing characters and main character's unique voice
- Outlining the book story
- Adjusting the story-world adding conflict and an antagonist, or a plot twist
- Adjusting the story-world adding suspense, curiosity and surprise
- Rewriting the story e.g. from main character's point of view

Once each story was finalised by ChatGPT, we recorded our processes, transporting every prompt and its answer to a singular document (which is included in the portfolio, in separate document.)

Once we had our stories, we were able to move onto the book production process. We used Canva as our main platform to bring the books to life. Thanks to internet research, we found out which format would be most suitable for book design. Because of this format, the pages of our books resembled real ones.

Necessary basis of every children book are pictures. To complete ours, we used Adobe Firefly(Beta) once again, due to its speed and clarity. After placing all images together on the book pages, we added the text of our stories. The font we used for the text is KG Primary Penmanship, as the research showed us that this is the most used and appropriate font to use in children's books. All in all, we believe the books represent the stories we created rightfully.
